# Weekly Email Highlight: Mrs. Brown

Religion - During Lent we are doing a daily meditation that includes a mini-lesson video, prayer, and something to think about for the day. The children have lenten crosses hanging on their desks that remind them of the promises they made for our journey through lent. Our topic in religion class is "The Bible".

Science - We are studying weather and climate.
