Weekly Highlight: Mrs. Smith's PreK Update

The PreK students continued their theme of construction this week with our focus being on exploring tools. We talked about the tools that builders and artists use. We discovered that tools make work easier.

Our centers this week allowed the students to explore and use simple machines. They built bridges and ramps trying to see what type of ramp would make the cars go faster. The students manipulated playdough using rollers, scissors, and wedges. With partners they created a building out of cardboard boxes. They were able to paint the boxes as well as cut out different shapes for doors and windows. The students built with tinkertoys, playsticks, legos, and cardboard bricks. They measured with unifix cubes and weighed different objects on a scale. The creativity will continue next week and I can't wait to see what they come up with!
