2025-2026 Dance Team Code of Conduct

- 1. The Dowling Catholic Dance Team (DCDT) will perform at Home Varsity Football and Home Varsity Basketball games. The DCDT will also perform at a variety of assemblies and exhibitions along with attending 3 day camp each summer. The Dowling Catholic Competition Team will compete at the ISDTA Championships and additional competitions as approved.
- 2. All dancers are expected to uphold the Dowling Catholic academic standards as written in the Dowling Catholic handbook (page 24-25) in order to participate on the Dance Team.
- 3. Any conduct that is embarrassing to the dancer or the dancers team may result in suspension or expulsion from the team. This includes drinking, smoking or vaping, profane language, disrespect, bullying or any actions unbecoming of a dance team member. If any actions involve illegal substances the dancer will be immediately expelled from the dance team. The coaches and the athletic director will be the judges of what is appropriate or inappropriate conduct.
- 4. The DCDT is considered a Fall and Winter Sport. Competition Dance Team members <u>MAY NOT</u> participate in another sport during the Fall or Winter Season. However, a dancer who is <u>ONLY</u> on the Pom Squad <u>MAY</u> participate in another Fall/Winter sport as long as they can make the practice schedule work and understand the attendance rules.
- 5. Freshmen dancers <u>may</u> participate in Freshman Fall Cheerleading AND the DCHS <u>Pom</u> Team. Freshmen <u>may not</u> participate in Fall Cheerleading AND the DCHS <u>Competition</u> Team.

- 7. Coaches will send the dance team calendar which will include all practices, competitions, games and events. Dancers are expected to work around this calendar. This includes all extracurricular activities.
- 8. All DCDT members will be required to attend the UDA Dance Camp. Camp is held at the beginning of July and all dancers will be responsible for 100% of the entire cost of camp.

Camp Details -

- UDA Convention Camp Omaha La Vista, Nebraska July 9th-12th
- 9. Choreography Camp for the Competition Team members is mandatory. No exceptions.

10. All DCDT members will be required to attend the ISDTA State competition on the days that the team competes. State solo is set for October 24th and State Dance Team is scheduled for December 3rd-5th.

State Details -

- ISDTA State Solos are held in Newton or Pella.
- ISDTA Dance Team Competition is held at Wells Fargo Arena/Hy-Vee Hall
- Dancers will miss a day (or two) of school for the team competition (this is considered an excused absence from school "field trip")
- 11. Attendance is required for all practices, games, events and camp.
 - All practices will be noted on the Dowling Catholic Dance Team Google Calendar.
 - If Dowling Catholic has a late start for school due to inclement weather, the Dowling Catholic dance team will not have morning practice.
 - Unexcused absences are unacceptable.
 - Dancers are expected to be at the practice prior to a performance.
 - Tardies to practice are unacceptable.
- 12. If a dancer has a conflict with a practice, game, or other event, the head coaches must receive an email notice of the absence a week in advance. This includes trips and school sponsored retreats. All communication should be emailed to DowlingCatholicDanceTeam@gmail.com.
- 13. In order to perform, dancers must have all pieces to the uniform. <u>If a dancer is missing any piece of their uniform, the dancer will sit out from the performance.</u>
- 14. All dancers will be required to have a current physical on file every year on the team.
- 15. Dancers are expected to give 100% effort at every practice, performance and event. If a dancer is not up to standard with the rest of the team at the last practice before a performance they will not perform. Coaches will make the final decision at the last practice prior to a performance. Dancers who do not bring their entire sideline and/or halftime outfit will not perform.
- 16. <u>DCDT members may not attend school sponsored retreats or trips during the months of October, November and December.</u>
- 17. DCDT members will purchase all costume pieces. It will be the dancer's responsibility to keep their costumes and poms in good condition or the dancer will be required to purchase new items. All uniform pieces will be reviewed in the spring. Coaches will decide if the dancers will use the same uniform pieces from the previous year or purchase new. If the coaches select to use the previous year's uniform pieces, only new members will be responsible for purchasing items.
- 18. Dance Team payments must be paid in \$200 increments. Payments are due to the Business Office on the 1st of the month starting in May. Final Dance Team balances must be paid in full prior to performing at the final basketball game or pep assembly. Balances not paid in full prior to tryouts will result in the dancer not being able to try out for the next year.
- 19. Dancers interested in competing as a State Soloists will tryout for a spot in August or September. Solosts must be on the Competition Team in order to tryout. The top 8 soloists will represent Dowling Catholic at the State Dance and Drill Team Competition in December. All dancers must be present and in costume for tryouts with their music submitted prior to the tryout. Video auditions will <u>not</u> be accepted.

<u>DOWLING CATHOLIC DANCE TEAM COST:</u> The following is an <u>ESTIMATE</u> of what the Competition and Pom Dance Team will cost for the upcoming season.
