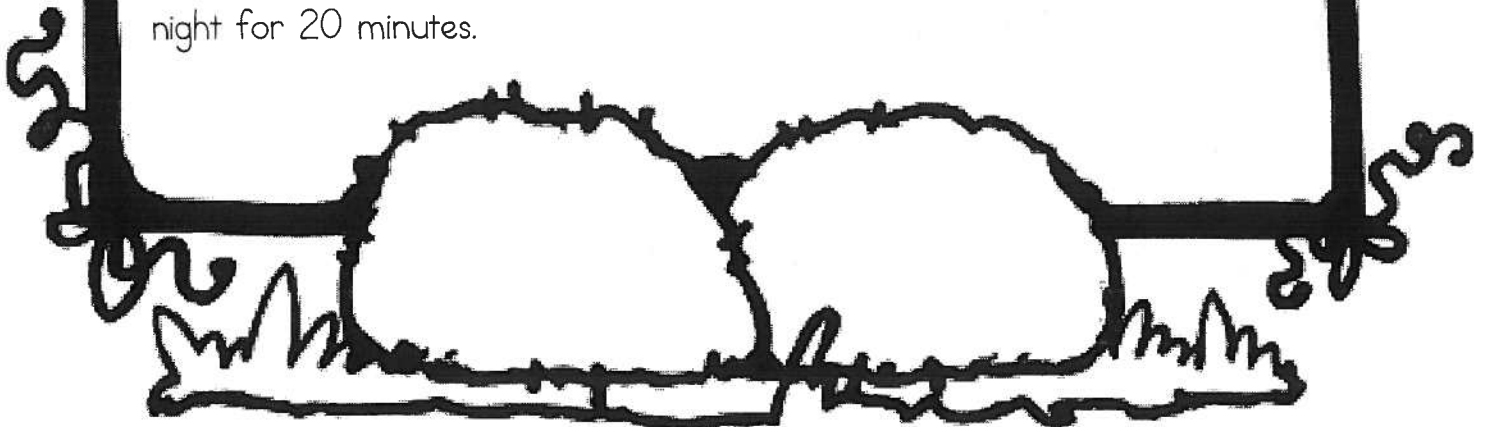


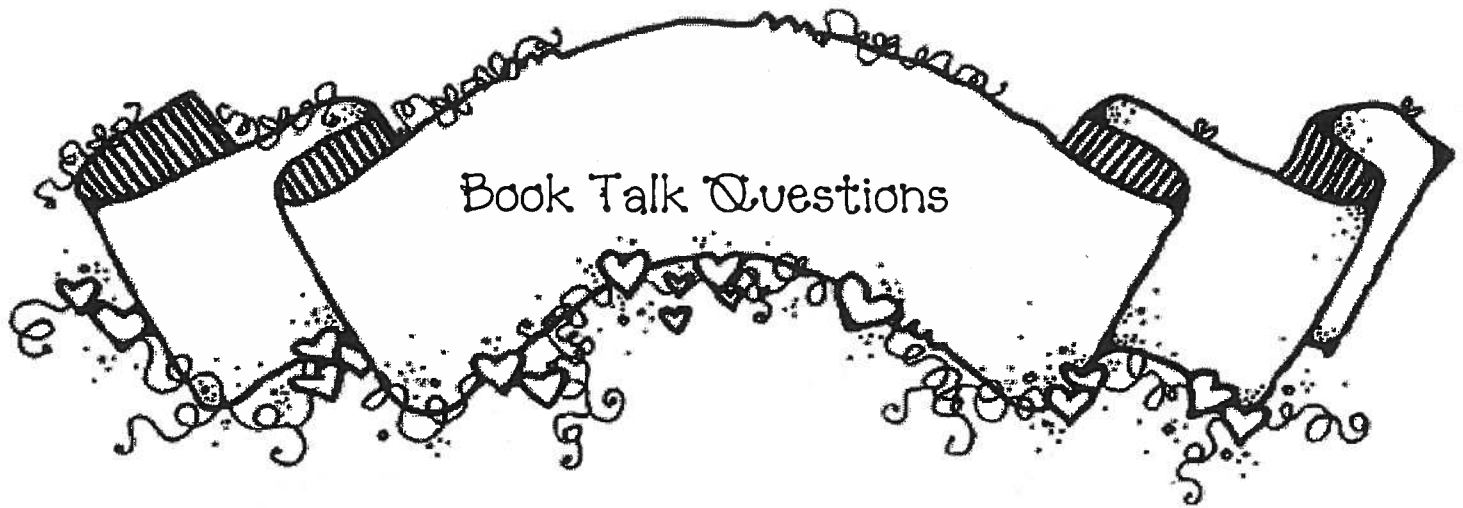


Book Talk Questions

This is a list of questions that good readers ask themselves as they read to help them both understand and enjoy their reading. Using these questions will help you have interesting talks with your child. Your child will learn to ask questions as they read and they will become strong readers.

Choose one question that makes sense to use for your book talk. After your book talk, have your child help you think about what you will write in the reading log. Thank you for reading with your child each night for 20 minutes.





1. Who is the main character? Did the main character's feelings change? When did they change?
2. What is the setting of the story? Draw a picture and describe it to your Mom or Dad.
3. Tell the beginning, middle and the end.
4. What is the main problem in this story? How does the character solve the problem?
5. Do the characters remind you of anyone you know?
6. Was there a part you thought was interesting, scary or funny? Tell why?
7. What was your favorite part of the story? Why?
8. Did you make a picture in your head of a part in this book?
9. Did this book remind you of any other book? Why?
10. Would you recommend this book to your friends? Why or why not?
